Initial formatting review criteria

The main document should:

- 1. Address a subject in line with the journal's aims.
- 2. Be limited to 5000 words for scientific articles, 3 000 words for scientific or technological notes and 6 000 words for review articles.
- 3. Have consecutively numbered pages.
- 4. Have 2.5 cm margins on all four sides.
- 5. Use 12-point Times New Roman font and 1.5-line spacing.
- 6. Have continuously numbered lines in the left margin, except for tables and figures.
- 7. Have a title with a maximum of 15 words, with scientific names therein written between parentheses.
- 8. Have scientific and active ingredient names, among others, presented in accordance with the guide for authors.
- 9. Format author information in accordance with the guide for authors.
- 10. Include the ORCID identifier (https://orcid.org/) of each author.
- 11. Provide author institutional affiliation with complete mailing address, email address and telephone number.
- 12. Include an abstract of up to 250 words for scientific articles and reviews, and 150 words for scientific or technological notes.
- 13. Use keywords in accordance with subject matter and the guide for authors.
- 14. List highlights in accordance with the guide for authors.
- 15. Include (if necessary) tables made in the Word processor table editor in accordance with the guide for authors.
- 16. Include (if necessary) equations made in the Word equation editor.
- 17. Avoid the use of the equation editor to insert symbols or variables within paragraphs of the manuscript (use the symbol insertion tool and present the variables in italics).
- 18. Use (if necessary) images of at least 300 ppi in resolution, a minimum of 945 x 945 pixels in size, and in JPG or TIFF format.
- 19. Display (if necessary) figures, graphs and flow charts as images, not as objects, and in accordance with the guide for authors.
- 20. Format references using the APA-7 standard.
- 21. Not use reference formatting (remove field codes).
- 22. Use fluent writing (low fog Index), which facilitates translation into Spanish.
- 23. Limit the length of paragraphs to 10 lines.
- 24. Not include text styles.
- 25. Present conclusions in accordance with the objectives and scope of the research.
